Item 2024:34:04 To approve the criteria for lateral entry (2nd and 3rd year) admissions in undergraduate programs as per National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Having discussed the agenda item, the Academic Council resolved that a committee may be constituted by the Vice Chancellor which will look into the whole gamut of issues involved in a lateral entry process in different academic programmes of the University including admission process (by entrance test and/or merit), credit requirement at each level etc. The committee will give its recommendation to the Vice Chancellor.

The Academic Council authorized the Vice Chancellor to take a final decision on lateral entry process after due perusal of recommendations given by the committee formed for this purpose.

Item 2024:34:05 To approve the provision of a special back examination for students in old undergraduate programs (Old CBCS system) which are not as per NEP 2020 guidelines.

Having discussed the agenda item, the Academic Council granted its approval for organizing a special back examination for students in old undergraduate programs (Old CBCS system) which are not as per NEP 2020 guidelines.

Item 2024:34:06 To approve the Registration in Ph.D. Programme in part time mode for Regular/ Contractual/ Guest faculty of Doon university.

Having considered the agenda item, the Academic Council approved for allowing only the regular faculty members working at the University to register for a part-time Ph.D. program at the Doon University.

Item 2024:34:07 To approve Ward Quota for admission of the Wards (sons/ daughters) of the regular employees of the Doon university.

Having considered the agenda item, the Academic Council resolved that *One* seat may be reserved in each program of the University for admissions of sons/daughters of the Regular/UPNL university employees (both teaching and non-teaching staff) based on merit (qualifying examination and/or

entrance test) among the applicants under this quota, provided that the ward concerned meets the minimum eligibility conditions for admissions in the academic programme. The ward quota admissions will be over and above the sanctioned number of seats in each academic programme of the University.
