

Introduction to NSS (National Service Scheme)

The NSS, a voluntary and value based student youth programme is one of the major youth schemes being operated in the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. The Motto of NSS "**Not Me but You**", reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for self-less service. The NSS is graduation based program (only the graduation students may register for it).

The educational goal of the NSS implies that besides gaining understanding of concepts like community, social structure, power conflict, etc. occurring in real life situations, students should acquire competence in the field of programme planning. Shouldering the responsibilities, participation in cooperative task and promotional work in the community.

- A National service scheme participants selected after a rigorous test participates in the Republic day parade camp for 3 weeks at New Delhi every year.
- NSS volunteer completing 240 hours of regular community service in a period of two years is to be issued an NSS certificate.
