About Vatsalya Club

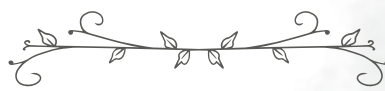


The famous English philosopher Francis Bacon famously said: "**Reading maketh a full man; conference a ready man; and writing an exact man.**"

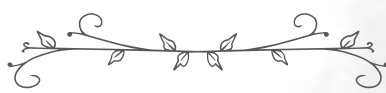
The Gaura Devi National Debate: A Legacy in the Making

Guidelines

THE TOPIC FOR THE DEBATE COMPETITION:

DEBATE FORMAT & RULES: Team Formation:

- Each university/ college will consist of minimum of 1 team (One speaker For the Motion & One speaker Against the Motion).
Maximum of 2 teams are allowed (One in English language another in Hindi Language)
- Each speaker will be allotted 4 **minutes**, structured as follow:
 1. 3 minutes – Main speech, 1 minutes – Conclusion
 2. A single bell will ring at the completion of 3 minutes.
 3. A double bell will ring at 4 minutes, marking the end of the allotted time.
 4. Exceeding the time limit will attract negative marking.

LANGUAGE RULE:

1. Use only one language throughout: either English or Hindi.
 2. No mixing of languages mid-speech.
- Rebuttals will be of one minute.
 - Cross-questioning is not allowed.

DISCIPLINE:

1. No unparliamentary language.
2. Explicit reading from paper is prohibited.
3. Maintain respectful, formal conduct at all times.



Miscellaneous

1. Each College/ University may send maximum two teams (Hindi and English) comprising of two individuals each.
2. To ensure a smooth beginning, participants are requested to arrive by 9:00 AM. Participant must be carrying their student identity card of the concerned university or college.
3. Participants are requested to wear proper formal attire (e.g., suits, dresses, etc.). University uniforms are not allowed to maintain anonymity.
4. The participants shall be provided accommodation within the campus, if it is opted by them at a nominal cost.
5. Upon completion of the payment, upload the screenshot of the confirmation in the google form.
